ITEMS COVERED BY ACT 2012-256

Covered items must cost \$60.00 or less, except for generators, which are covered as long as they cost \$1,000.00 or less.

AAA-cell, AA-cell, C-cell, D-cell, 6-volt, and 9-volt, including cellular phone batteries and chargers
(TAXABLE: Coin batteries, automobile and boat batteries are taxable)
Portable self-powered radios and battery-powered radios
Two-way radios, weather band radios and NOAA weather radios
Portable self-powered light sources (Battery-powered flashlights, lanterns, and emergency glow sticks)
Tarpaulins, plastic sheeting, plastic drop clothes, other flexible waterproof sheeting
Ground anchor system such as bungee cords or rope or tie-down kits
Duct tape
Plywood, window film or other materials specifically designed to protect window coverings
Non-electric food storage cooler
Non-electric water storage container
Non-electric can opener
Any artificial ice, blue ice, ice packs, reusable ice
Self-contained first aid kits
Fire extinguishers, smoke detectors, and carbon monoxide detectors
Gas or Diesel fuel containers

EXEMPT:

A single purchase with a sales price of \$1,000.00 or less

Any portable generator and power cord – used to provide light or communications or preserve food in the event of a power outage
